

Continuing Professional Development Guide

It's your duty and responsibility to keep your CPD up to date; and we've made it easy and simple to do!

Increasingly, professionals in many walks of life are expected to provide evidence of CPD and marine surveying is no different, especially as technologies, equipment and materials are constantly evolving.



Points Table*

Remember that it is a mandatory requirement to achieve a minimum of 10 CPD points per renewal year.

Activity	Points	Comments
Subscription to a marine publication, journal or magazine. Receipt of regular professional/industry updates.	1	Maximum two per year permitted
Networking or visiting a technical exhibition or other recognised maritime-related event.	1	Maximum two per year permitted
Researching a relevant technical subject, seeking advice on technical helplines or viewing relevant online videos.	2	
Purchase of an IIMS handy guide.	2	Maximum two per year permitted
Newly awarded affiliation to a relevant professional membership body.	2	Maximum two per year permitted
Submission of a completed eCMID/eMISW or other similar inspection report and/or participation in FMEA/DP trials as part of your routine occupation.	2	Maximum two per year permitted
Supervising and mentoring a new trainee AVI or undertaking supervision and mentoring from an approved AVI or senior colleague on new activities.	3	
Purchase of Festival of Knowledge Video.	3	
Publication of an article in a marine-related magazine, newsletter or website.	4	Maximum two per year permitted
Presentation or guest speaker at an IMCA/IIMS or another relevant event.	4	Maximum two per year permitted
Online or in-person attendance at any IMCA/IIMS organised seminar, conference, section meeting or training session.	4	
Online attendance at Festival of Knowledge	4	
Attendance at a relevant event held by another reputable organisation, e.g. OCIMF, NI, etc.	4	
Award of a newly attained and formally recognised marine qualification.	4	
Newly attained internal/external promotion or completion of structured/formal training.	4	
Preparation of technical reports for insurers, litigation or arbitration purposes. Participation as an expert witness (court or arbitration appearance).	4	Maximum two per year permitted
Other forms of ad hoc CPD for items not in the above table will be considered and points awarded accordingly.	1-4	Details will be required, and up to 4 points may be awarded

* **Please note:** Some of the activities have a limit to the number of claims you can make.

Using the App and making a claim

Each AVI has a unique log in using their email address and a pre-set password which must be reset on first access. AVIs are encouraged to claim points in real time rather than saving up a claim for months. So for example, let's say an AVI attended an eCMID Accreditation Course yesterday. At the end of the event, or once home, the AVI can open the App to make a claim for 4 points for the event from the list of activities in "Claim CPD Points". Click on the activity and follow the instructions to submit your claim.

Once your claim is submitted, an automatic email comes back to you to advise that your claim has been submitted and will be reviewed soon. At the same time an email comes into our team advising that an AVI has claimed 4 points for attending the Course.

The eCMID CPD Administrator will click to accept or decline each claim. Assuming the claim is verified and accepted, an email is automatically sent back to the AVI to inform them that 4 CPD points have been credited to their CPD account and that they now only require 6 more points to fulfil the eCMID CPD criteria. AVIs can check their CPD account to see that the points have been allocated and added successfully. This process repeats each time an AVI makes a successful CPD points claim, with the number required counting down automatically.

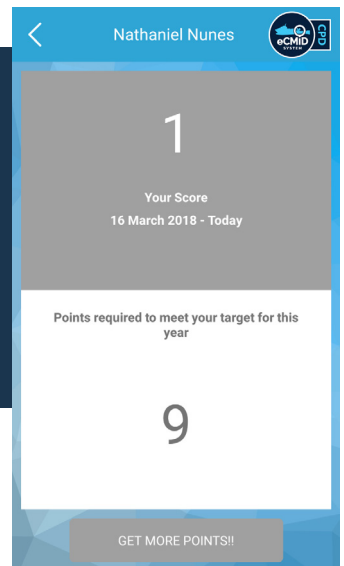
AVIs are expected to achieve a minimum of 10 CPD points accrued over a fixed one-year period from the date of their annual renewal, eg 1 November 2018 to 31 October 2019. After the one-year term the accrued points will be reset back to zero. There is no limit to the number of points an AVI can claim in a year, however points cannot be carried forward to the following year. An AVI is required to send attachments to verify their claims.

An example of a typical CPD claim:

Submission of two eCMID reports	= 4 points
Subscription to a professional journal	= 1 point
Attend the eCMID Accreditation Course	= 4 points
Visit a technical exhibition	= 1 point

The AVI has now accrued the minimum 10 points required.

In the event an AVI does not make any CPD claims during the year, they will be reminded periodically by email that they have a duty and responsibility to acquire the necessary points by the annual expiry date of their renewal.



Evidencing your CPD claim

AVIs are sometimes disappointed when a claim for CPD points is rejected. The only reason this will happen as a rule is when insufficient evidence to substantiate your claim has been submitted. So, you are reminded that it is vital to ensure your claim comes with the appropriate evidence (if required for that activity) so we can easily accept your request. Attachments can be sent with each claim, so take a photograph of a certificate or document that proves your claim. For example, let's say you attended a maritime related exhibition. Take a selfie photo of yourself at the event and attach it to the App with your claim as proof! We'll approve it.
